## Where can I find Toolkit SID file ?

ToolKit may ask for a **\*.SID** file during the first connection to that device. Once the directory of the file got defined, ToolKit will not ask again.

The **\*.SID** file gets copied and is located in the same directory as the **\*.WTOOL** file.

If you don't have the **\*.SID** file yet, many controls configuration files can get downloaded here:

- download the **\*.MSI** file (Microsoft Installer Package), which contains the **\*.WTOOL** and **\*.SID** file

File types for your reference:

**\*.WTOOL** File = contains all display screens and pages for online configuration, which are associated with the respective **\*.SID** file.

**\*.SID** File = contain all display and configuration parameters available in ToolKit

**\*.WSET** File = contain all settings of the ToolKit configuration parameters provided by the **SID** file or user-defined settings read from the unit.

Please add or modify the file location directory:



**Woodward Windows based installers, got changed over time, which results in different possible SID file directories:**

- C:\ProgramData\Woodward\ToolKit\Applications (ProgramData is a hidden folder in default settings of Microsoft)
- C:\Program Files (x86)\Woodward\ToolKit\Applications
- C:\Users\username\Documents\Woodward\ToolKit\Applications
- user-defined locations
